What is unclaimed property?

Unclaimed property includes forgotten funds like bank accounts, paychecks, refunds, stocks and even safe deposit box contents that are handed over to the state for safekeeping when owners can't be located. This means there could be valuable property in your name—waiting to be claimed!

When does property become unclaimed?

Unclaimed property often results from life's transitions, like moving or a loved one passing away. For example, if a family doesn't know about a relative's safety deposit box, its contents may become unclaimed property. Many Oklahomans have unclaimed property without realizing it—make sure you're not one of them!

How do I know if I have unclaimed property?

It only takes a minute! Scan the QR code below or visit YourMoney.OK.gov. Type in your name, and you'll instantly see if there's unclaimed property waiting for you.

How do I claim my property?

If you find property in your name, start a claim on the website. You can upload the required documents directly to YourMoney.OK.gov or send them by email or mail. The Oklahoma State Treasurer's Office is here to make the process easy and help you reclaim what's rightfully yours.
